We have created this privacy notice in order to demonstrate our commitment to the privacy of our customers.

What information we collect

When you contact us for further information on what slurry solutions we can provide for you, we will collect some personal information to ensure that we can contact you when moving forward with our services.

Who we are

Tim Welsh Enterprises gathers and processes your personal information in accordance with this privacy notice and in compliance with the relevant data protection Regulation and laws. This notice provides you with the necessary information regarding your rights and our obligations, and explains how, why and when we process your personal data.

Information That We Collect

Tim Welsh Enterprises processes your personal information to meet our legal and statutory obligations. We will never collect any unnecessary personal data from you and do not process your information in any way, other than as specified in this notice.

We are also required under UK tax laws to keep your personal data for a minimum of 7 years after which time, if no further business has been received it will be deleted from our system.

How we use your Personal Data (*Legal Basis for Processing*)

Tim Welsh Enterprises takes your privacy very seriously and will never disclose, share or sell your data without your consent, unless required to do so by law.

Your Rights

You have the right to access any personal information that Tim Welsh Enterprises processes about you and to request information about:-

- What personal data we hold about you
- The purpose of the processing
- The categories of personal data concerned
- How long we intend to store your personal data for

If you believe that we hold any incomplete or inaccurate data about you, you have the right to ask us to correct and/or complete the information and we will strive to do so as quickly as possible; unless there is a valid reason for not doing so, at which point you will be notified.

You also have the right to request erasure of your personal data or to restrict processing in accordance with the data protection laws.

If we receive a request from you to exercise any of the above rights, we may ask you to verify your identity before acting on the request; this is to ensure that your data is protected and kept secure.

Sharing and Disclosing Your Personal information

We do not share or disclose any of your personal information without your consent, other than for the purposes specified in this notice or where there is a legal requirement.
